DRIVING ON ICY ROADS!

When driving in winter:

-Accelerate and decelerate gradually... -Drive slowly...

-The normal dry pavement following distance of three to four seconds should be increased to eight to ten seconds...



-Know your brakes... Avoid abrupt stopping... -Don't power up hills... -Don't stop going up a hill... -Put vehicle in 4x4...



- Change to winter tires from summer tires

When coming into contact with ice:

DON'T SLAM ON THE BRAKES!

Braking can trigger slides & make an existing slide worse

TURN INTO THE SLIDE!

Turn your wheels in the direction that the rear of the vehicle is sliding

DON'T PANIC & DON'T OVERCORRECT!

Overcorrecting may send the car into an unrecoverable spin
