

DRIVING ON ICY ROADS!

When driving in winter:

- Accelerate and decelerate gradually...
- Drive slowly...
- The normal dry pavement following distance of three to four seconds should be increased to eight to ten seconds...



- Know your brakes...
Avoid abrupt stopping...
- Don't power up hills...
- Don't stop going up a hill...
- Put vehicle in 4x4...



- Change to winter tires from summer tires

When coming into contact with ice:

**BLACK
ICE!**

DON'T SLAM ON THE BRAKES!

Braking can trigger slides & make an existing slide worse

TURN INTO THE SLIDE!

Turn your wheels in the direction that the rear of the vehicle is sliding

DON'T PANIC & DON'T OVERCORRECT!

Overcorrecting may send the car into an unrecoverable spin
