

# DRIVING ON ICY ROADS!

## When driving in winter:

- Accelerate and decelerate gradually...
- Drive slowly...

-The normal dry pavement following distance of three to four seconds should be increased to eight to ten seconds...



- Know your brakes...  
Avoid abrupt stopping...
- Don't power up hills...  
-Don't stop going up a hill...  
-Put vehicle in 4x4...



- Change to winter tires from summer tires

## When coming into contact with ice:

**BLACK  
ICE!**

### **DON'T SLAM ON THE BRAKES!**

Braking can trigger slides & make an existing slide worse

### **TURN INTO THE SLIDE!**

Turn your wheels in the direction that the rear of the vehicle is sliding

### **DON'T PANIC & DON'T OVERCORRECT!**

Overcorrecting may send the car into an unrecoverable spin
