Did You Know?

Many of our serious injuries involve energized equipment. An injury is considered a serious injury if it involves a 2nd/3rd degree burn, amputation, fracture, concussion, crush or dislocation

No one's simple mistake should cost them their **life**

Lock out is a High Risk task and by providing lock out verification we are having another trained and competent employee double check to help minimize the risk of making a mistake

Think Safety First!

At each West Fraser division, lock out is performed on the equipment an average of 500 times per week. That is almost 2 million times per year. Even if we are 99% accurate, that means we still have 20,000 incorrect lock outs per year. The risk is too high NOT to do lock out verification

Expectations:

- 100% of lock outs MUST be verified including Contractor lockout and all application of Hold locks.
- Any employee that is required to lockout equipment must follow the correct work procedure and their associated training
- Each employee is responsible for their lockout, and the assurance that all equipment if fully deenergized.
 - Independently apply your locks and have your lockout verified for accuracy Each time locks are applied, test for zero energy must be verified
