## Safe Work Practices for Operators:

---

- ✓ Know equipment safety features
- ✓ Inspect equipment
- ✓ Look out for pedestrians
- ✓ Walk around equipment
- ✓ Know blind spots
- ✓ Turn & look behind
- ✓ Get pedestrians attention
- ✓ Limit backing up
- ✓ Maintain line of sight
- ✓ Drive a safe speed
- ✓ Stay out of pedestrian's walkways/control zones
- ✓ Lower forklift in high pedestrian areas
- ✓ Follow company rules

### High Risk Areas

- ✓ Heavy traffic
- ✓ Restricted Visibility
- ✓ Material flow/transfer
- ✓ Roadways
- ✓ Loading railcars

### Pedestrians

- ✓ Distracted
- ✓ Rushing
- ✓ Not following training
- ✓ Improper operation
- ✓ Ignoring safety rules
- ✓ Horseplay

### Environment

- ✓ Blind spots
- ✓ Slippery, uneven surfaces
- ✓ Congestion
- ✓ Poor visibility
- ✓ Pedestrians nearby
