ROLLING LADDER SAFETY!



- Do not attempt to gain additional height by standing on boxes or buckets on top of rolling ladder
- Use the step break/lock if equipped
- **Never tamper or modify ladder (remove** handrails)
- Be aware of your surroundings before setting up rolling ladder (e.g.- tools, vehicles, doors)
- Never stand with one foot on ladder and the other on a object such as shelfing or pipes
- Do not move an occupied ladder
- Do not stand on the handrails

To Lock It!

- Do not over reach- over reaching could cause the ladder to tip over
- Climb rolling ladder using 3-point contact- do not carry loads that are too bulky or heavy
- Rolling ladders should be climbed facing the ladder-**Not facing outwards**
- · Inspect rolling ladders before using them and if they are stored outside make sure they are protected by all weather conditions
- Rolling ladders that have missing rubber "feet" should have them replaced and if they are damaged or "sprung" make sure they are removed from service for repairs
