SUMMER DRIVING SAFETY TIPS



- BEWARE OF HEAT STROKE
- To prevent heatstroke, remember to ACT: Avoid heatstroke-related injury or death by never leaving your child or pet alone in the car. Create reminders and habits that give you a safety net. Take action and call 911 if you see and unattended child or pet in a vehicle
- THE SUN CAN BE DANGEROUS
- In glare conditions, slow down, increase your following distance and use caution, especially in areas with pedestrian or heavy traffic
- CREATE A PLAN FOR NAVIGATING DURING SUMMER SHOWERS

Remember to replace windshield wipers, check headlights, and ensure tires have proper tread depth and pressure. When driving in rainy conditions, avoid using cruise control, slow down, and make sure headlights are turned on
