No Bulge is a “Safe” Bulge

Tire Inspection



- Inspect all hoses for wear and leaks
- Check for loose lug nuts and general wheel condition
- Look at tires for imbedded stones, foreign material, cuts, overall tread condition, and sidewall condition
- Check tire pressure and verify correctness before beginning work

- Always verify the tire is filled appropriately
 - This includes appropriate air pressure
 - This includes appropriate chemical to air ratio.
- Remove tire from service as soon as any bulge is discovered.
- Replace tires on an appropriate tire replacement schedule.
 - Do not run to failure or risk a blow out.
