Where is black ice most likely to form?

- ☐ Have you entered an area that does not get much sunshine?
- ☐ *Is there a bridge or overpass on your route?*
- ☐ Do you travel along rivers, streams, or other sources of water vapour?

What should you do if you've hit black ice?

- ☐ Stay Calm
- ☐ *Keep the steering wheel straight, or steer in the direction you want to travel.*
- ☐ Avoid using your brakes, ease off the gas and shift into a lower gear.
- ☐ *If you must brake, pump them lightly.*
