1.0) West Fraser Dust Mitigation & Control Program

Each Division must develop a site specific Wood Dust Mitigation & Control Program based on the following 11 Elements.

- 1. Wood Dust identification in the workplace**
- 2. Identification of ignition sources**
- 3. Hazard assessment to determine the risks of wood dust in the workplace**
- 4. Hazard mitigation and control process**
- 5. Change management process**
- 6. Corrective action management process**
- 7. Fire investigation process**
- 8. Operational responsibilities & accountabilities**
- 9. Orientation & training of employees & contractors**
- 10. Fire and emergency plan**
- 11. Annual program review**
