

CRANE OPERATIONS

PRECAUTIONS FOR WORKING WITH OR NEAR A LOAD

If you see a load coming, move out of the way and don't forget to alert your work mates.

If you working in or passing through a lift area, make eye contact with the crane operator before proceeding near the crane

Tag lines help keep a load under control

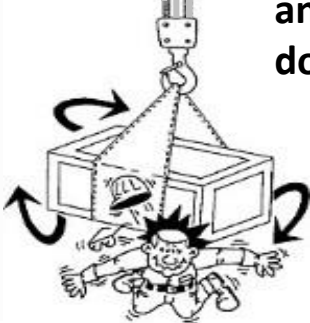
Every effort should be made to avoid having to move the load over an active work area. If this cannot be done, work should be temporarily halted and the area cleared while the pick is taking place.

Ensure that while guiding a load with a tag line that your travel path is clear and safe *before* the load is suspended.



If you lose the tag line and the load starts to swing or spin and develop momentum. Alert the operator and let it settle down on it's own.

Never loop the tag line around your hand, arm, or body. This could cause you to be dragged along with the load. Wear gloves to avoid rope burn.
