

Proxy CPP Rep



A proxy CPP Rep is a person qualified by their manager to supervise and act as a liason between contractor companies and Cariboo Pulp.

Depending on the scope of work and if they are working without a qualified supervisor onsite, they may be a supervisor for a job/crew.

If a Proxy CPP Rep is onsite, the CPP Rep can go offsite, but must be available and able to return to site if one of these issues occurs:

Safety: there is an incident requiring investigation such as medical aids, medical treatments, lost time, near miss having the potential to cause injury to a contractor, etc.



Production: there is an issue that will delay the project for two or more hours.

Environment: There is an issue that may result in the mill not complying with any of our environmental permits as a result of an incident.



Damage: There is a cause of significant property damage associated with the job.



Personnel: There is a serious personnel or community concern associated with the job.



Quality: There is an issue that may result in more than two hours of off-grade pulp to be created as a result of an incident associated with the job.

Issue or Question: that is unable to be answered by the Proxy CPP Rep.



The CPP Rep can attempt to address any issue faced by the Proxy CPP Rep through a phone conversation, but if requested by the Proxy CPP Rep, the CPP Rep must return to site.
