*Fall protection equipment (like harnesses and lanyards) should be removed immediately when no longer needed.*



There have been multiple occurrences throughout manufacturing facilities where a lanyard has become caught or entangled in moving equipment, after the worker's task had been completed and the equipment should have already been removed.

## Prevention

- Remove fall protection equipment immediately when it is not needed.
- Do not wear loose clothing, jewelry, have loose long hair, etc. when around moving equipment
- Make sure moving equipment has the proper guarding around it
- Establish, clearly mark, and communicate danger zones
