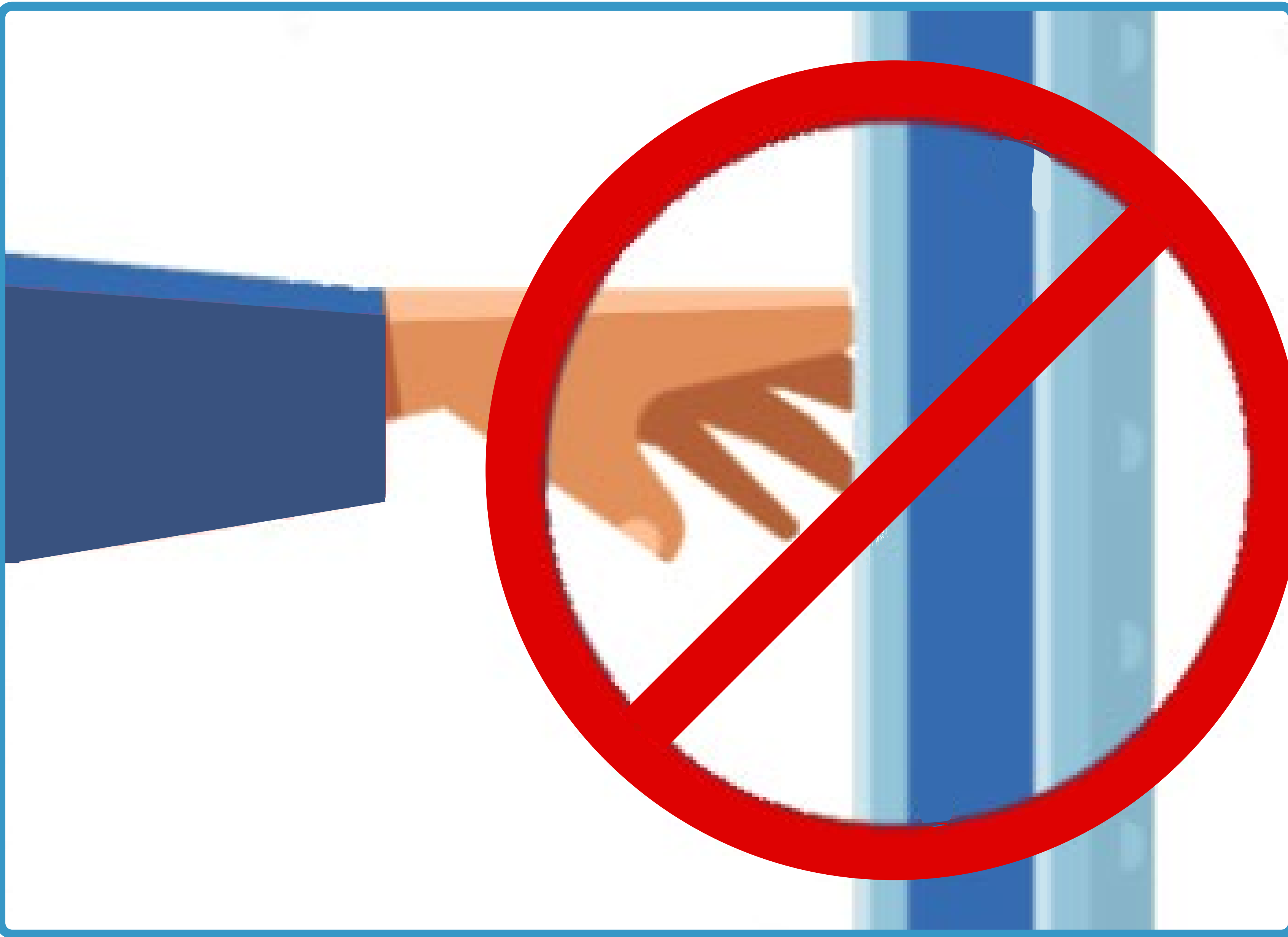


# Don't Touch Cold Metal!

In cold weather, touching any metal surface with your skin can be harmful. Metals absorb heat easily, so the heat from your body can quickly transfer to the metal, which can leave a burn (frostbite).



*The moisture in your skin can also freeze to the metal. If you do touch cold metal and get stuck, gently pour warm water over the stuck area until you're unstuck.*
