Impaired driving is operating a vehicle while your ability to do so has been compromised to any degree by consuming alcohol, (legal, illegal, prescribed or nonprescribed) drugs, or a combination of the above.

In addition to driving cars and trucks, impaired driving laws can also apply to those operating boats, bicycles, snowmobiles and off-road vehicles.



There is no good excuse for driving while impaired, and being a passenger with an impaired driver is also dangerous. There are options:

- make sure you have a designated driver
- call a friend or loved one to pick you up
- take public transit
- call a cab or a ridesharing service
