The 5 Ws of Field Level Hazard Assessments (FLHAs)

1 WHAT?

An FLHA card is a physical card that should be filled out by a worker about to complete a task.



2 WHERE?



FLHA cards are to be completed in the area where the task will take place to ensure workers have a full understanding of hazards in their work area.

3 WHY?

The purpose of an FLHA is to be a tool to assist in the identification of hazards and the elimination of all injuries.

| HAZARD | CONTROLS |
|--------------------------------------------|-----------------------------------------------------------|
| • chance of stored energy | • follow all LOTO rules: verification |
| • snags/pinch points while performing task | • good hand & body placement |
| • slips and trips | • housekeeping before, after & during task |
| • loud noises/hearing loss | • ear plugs or muffs |
| • over extension | • stretching before each task |
| • chance of drowning | • follow all safe work practices around open water |
| • chance of crane or forklift failure | • ensure operator is trained and do a pre-use inspection. |

4 WHO?



FLHA cards are to be used by all employees in all departments, and every person working on a task should be involved in filling one out.

5 WHEN?

An FLHA card should be filled out prior to starting a task, to make sure all hazards are identified and have controls in place.



Use an FLHA to identify all hazards and controls as well as the locations of all emergency equipment and evacuation routes in your area
