



Fireworks Safety



When using fireworks, it's essential to take precautions to ensure the safety of yourself and others around you.

Here are some precautions you can follow to prevent accidents and injuries:



Choose an appropriate location. Select a clean and open outdoor area away from buildings, dry grass, or other flammable materials (including trees, fireworks can and will start forest fires)



SAFETY INFORMATION

For out door use only. Avoid overhead obstructions. Do not fire near tall buildings, trees or similar. Place battery on flat ground and fix article firmly and upright to a solid post. Ensure top of article clears post. Remove orange fuse cover. Standing sideways, light fuse at its outermost end and retire immediately at least 8 metres. Spectators must be at least 15 metres.

Keep water sources nearby. Have a large bucket of water, a garden hose, or a fire extinguisher readily available in case of an emergency.

Read and follow instructions. Follow the manufacturer's guidelines regarding handling, lighting, and safety precautions.



Dispose of fireworks safely. After you're finished with the fireworks, douse them with water to make sure that they're fully extinguished. Allow them to cool down before disposing of them.

If you're unsure of how to safely handle fireworks, consider going to a professional fireworks display organized by trained individuals.
