

Labour & Service Contractors

Labour & Service contractors are contract and trades labour contractors that perform short or long term work for West Fraser.

Their knowledge, skills, and competency may or may not be known to West Fraser until they arrive on site, and the contractor may or may not provide dedicated and qualified supervision for the contractor employee(s).

Their work is under the direction and control of a West Fraser representative.

The West Fraser Representative must:

- Annually confirm the contractor's skills, certifications, and training
- Lock-out equipment, test it & ensure the contractor applies their personal lock. Labour & Service contractors cannot lock out equipment on their own.
- Visit the work location and perform a Site Hazard/ Risk Assessment with the contractor or group of contractors, listing all the known Hazard/Risks & Controls.
- Have contact with the contractor at the beginning and the end of the shift



CPP employees who will be bringing contractors on site must know and understand worker qualifications prior to their arrival on site, and ensure that their contractors have the proper training and that vendors can provide training documents at request.
