Key Components of a TieDown


Anchorage Points

Load Distribution



To prepare a site for high winds:

- Secure all loose materials
- Anchor temporary structures
- Tie down tarps and coverings
- Stabilize scaffolding and ladders
- Lower or secure cranes and hoists
- Park mobile equipment
- Remove or secure tools from elevated platforms and open areas.
